DAY 1 Depart Melbourne

DAY 2 Arrive Rome

Upon arrival in Rome transfer to your hotel where you will spend the next two days absorbing the splendour of this ancient city. **D**

DAY 3-4 Rome

Delve into the city's many formidable museums and basilicas, tantalize your taste buds with the unparalleled flavour of Italy and surround yourself with the pervading sense of history that is the Eternal City Rome. **B, D**

DAY 5 Rome/Naples

Transfer from Rome to Ravello, where you'll stay for the next three nights. Time permitting, we will visit Villa Cimbrone (Greta Garbo's retreat, commanding balcony views over the bay) before dinner. **B, D**

DAY 6 Ravello/Minori/Atrani (10km)

Walking through vines and terraces we reach the old chapel of San Nicola which commands stunning views of the Amalfi Coast. Descend to the pastel houses of Minori for lunch in the square before walking along the coast to diminutive Atrani. Local bus back to the hotel before dinner. **B, D**

DAY 7 Ravello/Pontone/Amalfi (10km)

Ravello is enchanting; 'must sees' include Moorish Villa Rufolo and its semi tropical gardens. After lunch follow a scenic path down to Ponte dello Ziro watchtower then descend to Amalfi. Local bus back to hotel. **B, D**

DAY 8 Sentiero degli Dei (11km)

Today we explore the 'Pathway of the Gods', Amalfi's most scenic walk. When Positano comes into sight, we have a bird's eye view of tiny boats, pretty villas, grey volcanic beaches and churches. Lunch in a traditional trattoria then transfer to our second hotel, in Massa Lubrense. **B, D**

DAY 9 Free Day

Day at leisure and the perfect chance to catch a hydrofoil across to Capri, arguably the most beautiful island in the Mediterranean. It has over 800 species of flowers and plants, and magnificent grottoes along the coast. **B, D**

DAY 10 Pompeii and Annunziata (11km)

First stop today is Pompeii where we will have a local guide to help bring this ancient city to life. After lunch visit Annunziata and explore its pretty park - before descending to the unspoilt port of Marina della Lobra. **B, D**

DAY 11 Punta Campanella (12km)

Walking through herb-scented scrubland, we reach Sorrento's 'Land's End' with breathtaking views across to Capri. In the afternoon we follow a coastal path back to our hotel in time for a limoncello by the sea before dinner. **B, D**

DAY 12 Massa Lubrense/Rome

Overnight in Rome. **B**

DAY 13 Depart Rome

DAY 14 In Transit

DAY 15 Arrive Melbourne
